1. Financial Assistance is available for grades K-8 only.
2. **Applicant must be an Actively Affiliated Catholic Family of Sacred Heart of Jesus Church** as defined on the Parish Affiliation form.

4. If granted, financial assistance will be for the **current academic** year only.

3. New Students from
  - a. Actively affiliated Sacred Heart of Jesus Parishioner families
  - b. Actively affiliated families of another Catholic parish
  - c. Non-affiliated families
